Since then, we've become a regional leader in helping urban and rural people build local food systems. We transform the Learning Center into a living classroom for over 2,000 children and adults each year. Graduates of our farmer training program now lead dozens of new sustainable local farms in the region. And from urban gardens to farmers' markets, we help more than 4,000 participants in low-income Chicago and Rockford neighborhoods develop local food systems projects that increase access to fresh, healthy food and improve the quality of life.
